DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER No. 910-21-01

ALL CHANNEL COAST DISTRICT UNITS

E-Bike Permissions and Prohibitions

1. The dramatic growth and popularity of electric assisted or propelled bicycles (E-Bikes) within the State of California is impacting the unique trail and backcountry experiences afforded by the Channel Coast District and e-bikes are an emergent technology generally inconsistent with the park experience that may have negative impacts on the special resources and regional wildlife found within the Channel Coast District.
2. Effective immediately and concurrent with Departmental Notice 2021-04 Electric Bicycles, the following units **allow** the use of Class 1 E-Bikes on trail locations where bicycles are currently allowed:
  - McGrath State Beach, San Buenaventura State Beach, Emma Wood State Beach, Carpinteria State Beach, El Capitan State Beach, Refugio State Beach, Gaviota State Park, La Purisma State Historic Park.
3. Effective immediately and concurrent with Departmental Notice 2021-04 Electric Bicycles, the following CA State Parks units prohibit Class 1 E-Bikes on any trail locations where bicycles are currently allowed:
  - Mandalay State Beach, Chumash Painted Cave State Historic Park, Point Sal State Beach
4. Effective immediately and concurrent with Departmental Notice 2021-04 Electric Bicycles, the following units **prohibit** the use of Class 2 and Class 3 E-Bikes on trail locations where bicycles are currently allowed:
  - Mandalay State Beach, McGrath State Beach, San Buenaventura State Beach, Emma Wood State Beach, Chumash Painted Cave State Historic Park, Carpinteria State Beach, El Capitan State Beach, Refugio State Beach, Gaviota State Park, La Purisma State Historic Park, Point Sal State Beach.
